Covid-19 Safety:

- Masks are required for guests who are unvaccinated or under age 12.
- Masks are optional for guests who are vaccinated.
- Stay home if you display any COVID-19 symptoms: fever, chills, cough, shortness of breath, a new sore throat, new muscle aches, new headache, new loss of smell or taste.
- Stay home if you suspect you have been exposed to COVID-19 in the last 14 days.
- If you present any COVID-19 symptoms within 14 days of having been at the Paramount, notify us at 320-259-5463 or boxoffice@paramountarts.org.

Ticketing:

Tickets for most events will be sent by email. **Guests** will be asked to show either their paper ticket (printed at home) or e-ticket (on a mobile device) to a staff member or usher upon entry to the theatre.

Parking - NEW INFORMATION!

Parking in the City of St. Cloud - Paramount ramp is available every day of the week. It is free to park in the ramp after 5pm Monday through Friday and all day Saturday and Sunday. **NEW:** Daily parking is \$1.00 per hour. Prepayment is required at a pay station or through the [ParkMobile app](#) . There is a pay station located on the ground level of the parking ramp stairwell and also on 1st Street North, near the entrance to the ramp. There are also a number of metered parking spots on surrounding streets.

Be sure to plan extra time for parking, use of restrooms and purchasing concessions.
