Covid-19 Safety:

- **Face masks that cover the nose and mouth are required for all audience members, regardless of vaccine status.**
- Please stay home if:
 - You display any COVID-19 symptoms: fever, chills, cough, shortness of breath, a new sore throat, new muscle aches, new headache, new loss of smell or taste.
 - You suspect you have been exposed to COVID-19 in the last 14 days.

Parking - NEW INFORMATION!

Parking in the City of St. Cloud/Paramount ramp is available every day of the week. It is free to park in the ramp after 5pm Monday through Friday and all day Saturday and Sunday. Daily parking is \$1.00 per hour. **Prepayment is required** at a pay station or through the [ParkMobile app](#). The first 60 minutes are FREE in all ramps, all-day, for [ParkMobile app](#) users. Take note of your parking stall number when you park your vehicle; you will need it at the pay station. Pay stations are located on the ground level of the parking ramp stairwell and also on 1st Street North, near the entrance to the ramp. There are also a number of metered parking spots on surrounding streets.

Be sure to plan extra time for parking, use of restrooms and purchasing concessions.
